

## SCHOOL TRAVEL PLAN / STAR ACCREDITATION

### **STAR Track website goes live at Accreditation event; book your one-to-one meeting now!**

On October the 5<sup>th</sup> students and staff from schools across five east London Boroughs got together at Stratford Town Hall to receive their accreditation certificates and work together to learn new ways to promote sustainable travel and road safety.



Now that schools have settled into the 2012/13 academic year we would like to invite schools to book in a one-to-one meeting for November or December.

During a meeting we can show you how to use the new Transport for London STAR Track website for monitoring your School Travel Plan and help you to plan actions for the coming year.

**Reminder:** The easiest way to make sure your schools is eligible for accreditation next year is to book in your Hands-Up Survey in the school diary, ideally for mid-March. A template is attached to this email.

Please note that having an up-to-date school travel plan makes the school eligible for free cycle training, road safety workshops and possible engineering works. If your school has planned building works, it is a condition that a school have a current school travel plan in place before works are approved and implemented.
