To help us reach this target we would kindly ask that parents only request term time leave in exceptional circumstances. All other term time requests will remain as unauthorised absences.

We would like to remind parents to contact the school if your child is going to be absent or unwell and upon their return to school to provide any medical evidence.

In line with government regulations if your child's attendance falls below 90% in a term or there are 12 unauthorised sessions, a penalty notice of £60 per parent may be issued or a referral to the Attendance Management Service made.

We look forward to working with parents and carers again and hope that this year will be another successful year for attendance at Keir Hardie!
