KS1

Mapping skills – plan and design a simple map of a trip around your local area (Canning Town, Stratford, and London). This could be from your home to Westfield Shopping Centre, a local park, a museum or anywhere of interest...



KS2

Travelling abroad or locally over the summer break?

If you are, then why not plan and design your route to enhance those geography skills...

- Use a digital map or navigation to plan your route
- Observe, measure and record human and physical features at your chosen destination
- Compare human and physical features in the form of a table
- Sketch your own map, plan, and graph
- Create a PowerPoint/Google Slide on a visited country – include; weather, food, physical/ human features, population, changes over time to the environment.
