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Dear Parents/Carers

Thank you for all your positive comments regarding the remote learning, your feedback is valued and helps us in improving our systems. As most of you are aware the school will be operating for 4 and a half days. On Friday's pupils will attend school for half a day. Please note that your child will be coming home with a pack, enclosed in the pack will be study guides for Maths, Maths Pupil answer book and pupil study guide, Reading Comprehension, Spelling, Grammar and punctuation, Handwriting, Science, pencil, ruler and sharpener. The Science study guides will be used towards the end of the term/beginning of the Spring Term so please keep them safe.

In addition to this, the packs will contain a timetable for this week which will include the time that pupils should be working on in each area and the page referencing the for the study guides. This will also be posted on the google classroom. Work will be set for approximately 1hr40mins. Pupils must not work through the whole of the study guide in one session, the sections will be broken up into manageable chunks each week. Pupils must also use the google classroom to feedback to the teacher in terms of the level of difficulty. This will help the teacher to identify any pupil who has misconceptions. Teachers will address this on Monday morning. For pupils who do not have electronic devices, pupils will be given a paper comment sheet which they will need to fill in and hand it to the teacher.

Please note that the study guides have the answers within the books, all we ask is that pupils attempt the tasks without seeing the answers first, the only time they can view the answers is once they have completed the task or section. Once pupils complete the task at home on a Friday afternoon they will self assess using the answers provided. Our staff will also speak to the pupils about how to use the study guides, all we ask is that you ensure that your child attempts the tasks as honestly as possible.
