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Dear Parents

The Senior Leadership Team would like to take this opportunity to once again thank you for your support with our Remote Learning provision. We have been evaluating our current provision and are delighted to inform you that we have graded many aspects of our provision as outstanding. This high quality provision is possible with the feedback that you have shared with us, that allows us to further improve our current remote learning systems and procedures.

Feedback from the wellbeing parent calls indicates a high number of parents sharing their concerns over the amount of screen time that children are spending on-line, in response to this, the school will be introducing **Digital -Free Friday** from **Friday 12th February**.

Outline of the day:

Pupils log into the classroom at **9:00 am**. The teacher takes the register, class social interaction and explains the tasks that pupils need to complete by the end of the day on Friday. At 9:30 pupils will then log off and complete their assigned tasks. Tasks will be set to consolidate the week's learning linked to the Study Guides.

In addition to this, parents also said that they would like to see more opportunities for creative arts timetable. Activities will be planned around: PE, Art, Design and Technology, Scientific experiments, Music and opportunities to develop life skills linked to our MAGIC Moments. Our aim is to continue developing the holistic child and give our pupils different educational opportunities to achieve excellence.

Pupils will be expected to log back into the Google classroom in the afternoon at **1pm**. Friday afternoon assemblies will continue to be held, members of staff will register the pupils, have a wellbeing check and answer any questions. See an example below. Your child's teacher will also send out a timetable to help support you in outlining how you could structure your child's day, this will also be available on the website.
