Dear Parents/Carers

I hope this letter finds you well and you are enjoying the summer break. We are really looking forward to welcoming everyone back to school in September.

I write to confirm the details and arrangements for the opening of school from **Monday 6th September** (except Nursery - Nursery parents will have received their start date in July, but a reminder will be sent out at the end of next week via Parentmail). Please read the letter carefully, as it sets out all the information you will need to know for the start of term.

## September Return To School Guidance:

To ensure we continue to keep everyone safe and mitigate potential risk of Covid outbreaks, we will be continuing with the same procedures as we were using in the summer term, as recapped below:

- Pupils will continue to be dropped and collected via the same gates and staggered times as during the Summer Term (see table below)
- Pupils should not bring any equipment to school except for water bottles and school reading books.
- Pupils will be expected to wear school uniform, and wear their PE kit to school on the days that they have PE. The teacher will confirm these days with you when term starts.
- Nursery pupils will be in class bubbles.
- Reception and Nursery pupils will share the Early Years Outdoor Learning Spaces.

## Attendance

Attendance is compulsory. Your child is expected to come to school daily, unless they are unwell. If your child or anyone in your household develops any of the three main symptoms of COVID-19 (high fever, persistent cough, loss of taste and/or smell), **PLEASE DO NOT SEND YOUR CHILD TO SCHOOL** and let us know as soon as possible. We will ask that the person with symptoms has a test and that you confirm a negative result before we can allow your child to come back.

## Arrival & Dismissal Protocol:

- Only parents of pupils who may be distressed/dysregulated, SEND pupils, Year 2 and 3 can enter the school playground. (Only one parent will be allowed).

## As a school we will continue to:

- have increased cleaning hours during the day to maintain disinfection in between use of areas, toilets, staffroom, door handles, and complete the toilet log.
- Ensure the school is well stocked with resources - lidded bins, paper towel dispensers for all children/staff toilets
- All bubbles to have soap, sprays, antibacterial wipes and disposable paper towels
- All classrooms to have soap and water, a hand sanitizing station

## Breakfast Club/After School Care

Please note that we are no longer part of the free breakfast scheme, so only pupils who attend Breakfast Club from 8am at a cost of £1 will be given breakfast.

Both Breakfast Club (entry between 8am and 8:10am) and ASC (3:15 - 6:30pm) will start on Monday 6th September.
