Curiculum

At Keir Hardie our curriculum supports our pupils to be confident, independent, lifelong learners and reflects the pupils' cultural experiences. We enhance our curriculum by providing inspirational enrichment opportunities (frequent educational visits, visitors and the expertise of a range of specialists, including drama, dance and gymnastics).

We want our pupils to be happy, confident learners, with a wide range of opportunities to develop as critical thinkers.

Differentiated learning enables all our pupils to access the curriculum effectively. In Mathematics, we follow a mastery approach to teaching and learning, while our pupils develop into writers with opportunities to orally rehearse and imitate language before writing.

We have a commitment to teaching early reading through the Read Write Inc (RWI) phonics programme, while fostering a love of reading through daily whole class Reading for Pleasure, comprehension sessions and independent self-selection of books from the school library.


