## Personal Social and Emotional

**We will...**

- Talk about people who we care about such as our family members and our friends.

## Communication and Language

**We will...**

- Copy what adults do and take turns in conversations.
- Learn lots of new songs linked to our learning.
- Use full sentences to talk about stories and pictures.



## Literacy

**We will...**

- Continue to develop our phonics knowledge, through games.
- Begin to form the letters of our names.
- Make labels and lists.

## Mathematics
