Classes present:

Topic: Sustainability, food waste and pupil survey

Actions met since last meeting: Pupil Survey results have been distributed to subject leaders, phase leaders and SLT with questions to consider

Project 1: Food Waste

School councillors have paired up with lunch time pupil supervisors to address food waste at lunch.

Lunch time supervisors mentioned that some food is often eaten and leaves little waste such as: Chips, Pizza, rice and fish fingers.

Some food often has waste: cabbage and carrots.

School council and lunch time supervisors looked at the school lunch menu and suggested:

- Some days there are too much choice with 2 vegetarian options
- The lunch menu online was outdated and needed to be the current lunch on offer
- Pupils need to have a say in what lunch options are available as only office staff choose

Project 2: Pupil voice survey

77% of KS1 and majority of EYFS said that there was enough equipment to use at break times.

-Only 52% of KS2 pupils felt that there was enough equipment at break times.

KS1: Pupils suggested that more art, maths, reading, art and computing lessons/activities would make learning more fun. They also want to spend more time with friends and learning outdoors.

KS2: suggested that more playground equipment and classroom equipment in art, science and maths would make learning more fun. They would like more exciting trips, activities and dual language books. Children would also like more clubs at lunchtimes.

68% of KS2 pupils said that they enjoy coming to school

Next steps:

- School council and lunch time monitors will share sample lunch menu with class and children will make suggestions on what they like and what could be changed
- MsTaylor said she will work with pupils to add sensible suggestions to menu
