Actions since the last school council meeting:

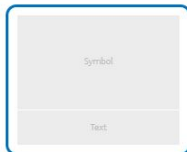
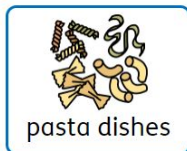
- Dev and Amreen analysed pupil data on lunches and wrote a recommendation letter to Ms Tailor.
