Types of bins at Keir Hardie

Bin type - Recycle/reuse Rubbish	What can go inside/How do recycle or dispose:
Water bottles, pens, plastic food containers	Hard plastics bin- <u>all classrooms</u>
Paper, card, paper cups and plates, flip chart paper	In Paper bin- <u>all classrooms</u> Please roll or fold large pieces of paper
Fruit and veg scraps, tea bags, egg shells, flowers, leaves	Compost bin- <u>EYFS</u>
Cardboard	Cardboard collection area by bins in the <u>car park</u>
Soft plastics such as wrapping, cling film.	Rubbish bin
Tin foil	Rubbish bin
Glass or tin cans	Blue bin- <u>Front office</u>
Batteries	Bucket by <u>Front office</u>

School councillors and Mr White will be monitoring how much waste we are producing and celebrating classrooms that reuse and recycle materials.

Agreed Actions/ Next Steps
