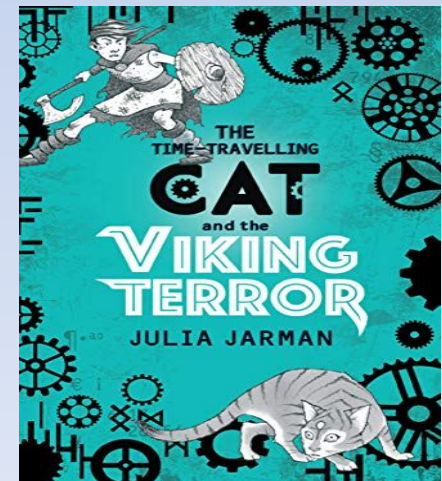
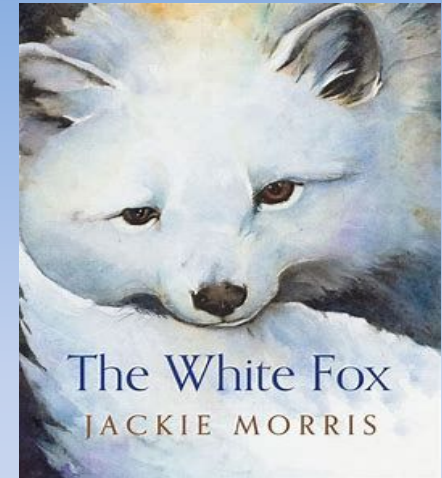
Strategies to support reading

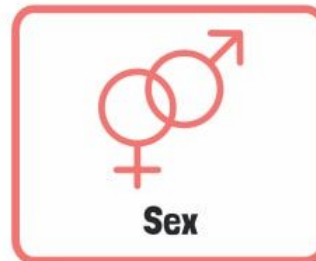
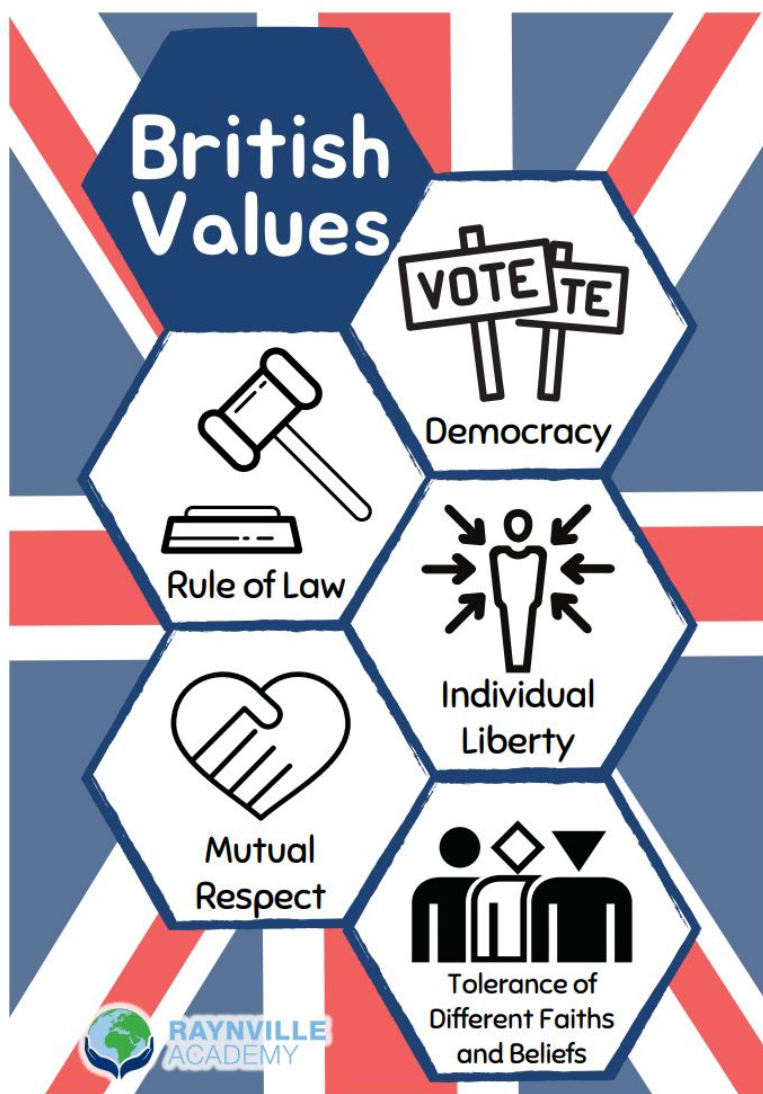

For pupils


