## Curriculum Topics

**English** – In English, pupils will learn about using dialogue to interrogate a text and produce a non-chronological report on amazing animals

**Maths** – In Maths, pupils will undertake themed projects and consolidate previous learning to support their transition to secondary school.

**Science** – In Science, pupils will learn the evolution and inheritance and consolidate previous learning.

**History** – In History, pupils will explore and research a historical study of James Keir Hardie

**Geography** - In Geography, pupils will learn about time zones and the significance of latitude and longitude as well as diversity focusing on Ghana and India (carnival)

**Art** – In Art, pupils will learn about sustainability and take part in a project on eco dyeing - linked with Design and Technology

**Computing** – In computing, pupils will learn about about VFX, 3D Modelling and Compositing as well as online safety - focusing on radicalisation and trolling

**RE** – In R.E, pupils will learn about the present qualities of religious leaders and inclusive celebrations

**PSHE (P4C)** – In PSHE, pupils will learn about physical health and wellbeing, growing and changing and transition to secondary school

**Music** – In Music, pupils will learn about music technology including composition with music, software and instruments

**Spanish** – In Spanish, pupils will learn about numbers up to 100, ordering food and the revision of the language

**PE** - In P.E, pupils will learn about the fundamental skills in tennis, swimming and dance

**DT** - In D&T, pupils will take part in the 'Save Make Reinvent' Project with Institute of Imagination - Junk bots.

## Homework

We continue to encourage our pupils to research and be curious learners, Homework supports your child to practice and consolidate their learning. Homework provided will usually be linked to what your child has learned that week or research in preparation for new learning. Homework will be given to the children on a **Friday** and they are expected to hand it in the following **Thursday**. We also have an online maths resources called **Sumdog and Times table RockStars**, please find your child's logins in their yellow Reading is Fun book. It is are great resources to help your child with fluency in mental arithmetic. Please continue to encourage your child to **read** for at least 20 mins each day.

From time to time, we will also set the children a project to complete at home linked to topics theory are learning. This is a great opportunity for you to work on a fun and creative project with your child and showcase your skills.

## Pupil Support

The school continues to work hard to narrow learning gaps, we have a number of ways to support some of our pupils, before and after school and during the school day. Your child may be asked to come into school at 8:15am to work on particular areas they find challenging in order to narrow these gaps. The morning sessions are from **Monday to Thursday**. Or your child may be invited to attend Booster sessions after school.
